What You Should Know





Prostitution is Not a Criminal Offense



Engaging in unregistered prostitution is not a criminal offense, provided you are legally permitted to work in Germany. However, it is considered an administrative offense.

What is an administrative offense? An administrative offense is a minor violation of the law that does not cause significant harm. It can result in a fine imposed by the authorities.

If you engage in prostitution, you are required to register with the Health and Public Order Office. Registration is free of charge.
